

ESIC Hospital Udaipur Conducted Health Camp and Road Safety–Focused BLS Training under National Road Safety Month 2026

In observance of National Road Safety Month (1–31 January 2026) and in alignment with the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways’ “Sadak Suraksha Abhiyan” themed “Seekh se Suraksha, Technology se Parivartan”, ESIC Hospital Udaipur organised a two-day Health Check-up and Awareness Camp at Nathdwara Mandir Trust.

As part of the initiative and in support of the national “Zero-Fatality Month”, a Basic Life Support (BLS) training session was conducted focusing on CPR, basic trauma care, bleeding control, and first response in road traffic emergencies. The session aimed at strengthening community preparedness and emergency response capacity.

The training was conducted by Dr. Prabodh Solanki, IMO Gr-II, and Dr. Mohit Arora, IMO Gr-II, under the guidance of Dr. Sunil Kumar Patidar, and under the supervision of Dr. P. C. Meghwal, Medical Superintendent, and Dr. Anuradha Gahlot, Deputy Medical Superintendent.

Beneficiaries also availed medical consultations and health screening services during the camp.
